Reading Task

Can you read one story per day with your grown ups until Sunday 21st February.

Why not take it in turns to read to each other.

Once you have read the story can you fill out a story map to share what happened in your chosen stories when we return.

Children can draw a picture in each box and grown ups can you write a short sentence to explain what is happening.

This is a great opportunity to share stories and open up discussions.

I have attached a template story map for printing and an example of a story map. If you are unable to print you can create your own on paper. You do not have to use this example; you may want to research other examples of preschool story mapping. Be as creative as you like.
